22 NOVEMBER: 25th SERVAIS CONCERT

The University Symphonic Orchestra of the Catholic University of Louvain has built a strong reputation. Together with cellist Didier Poskin it will perform Servais' cello concerto in b minor. For the first time since 1957 people in Halle can hear and enjoy this sublime concerto. Also the 'Ode à Claude Debussy' by Frits Celis and the Symphony no.2 by Alexandr Borodin are part of the program.



SERVAIS IN PARIS

The University Symphonic Orchestra of the Catholic University of Louvain will not only perform the Servais concerto in Halle on 22 November but played it already in other places. They gave three concerts in Paris: on 29 October at the Fondation Biermans-Lapôtre, on 30 October in de Faculté des Sciences de Sorbonne Université and on 31 October in the Eglise Saint-Christophe de Javel.

On 7 and 8 November the USO will play the Halle program in its home town Louvain.

IN MEMORIAM ANNER BIJLSMA 1934-2019

On 25 July 2019 Anner Bijlsma, icon among the Dutch cellists, deceased in Amsterdam. The 85th years old cellist could look back upon a rich career of more than sixty years.

Anner Bijsma was strongly committed to the less known cello repertoire by among others Franchomme, Dotzauer and Servais. Already around 1970 he recorded Servais' Souvenir de Spa, followed later on by a complete cd with work by Servais. Bijlsma played the 'Servais Strad' at 8 cd recordings between 1986 and 1995. Playing Servais' cello had been a special experience for him.

was an enthousiastic supporter. He was guest of honour on Servais' bicentenary birthday on 6 June 2007 in Halle. Later he regularly visited the Servais stand at the occasion of the cello biennale in Amsterdam. In 2009 he became honorary member of the Servais Society.

NEW CD: PASSACAGLIA

In Japan the cd 'Passacaglia' came out. Among other works violinist Ryo Mikomi and cellist RIntaro Kaneko chose the 'Variations brillantes et concertantes sur l'air 'God Save the King' by Servais and Joseph Ghys for this recording. The cd also contains pieces by Händel, Bach, Piazzola, Rossini and Mozart.
