### SUCCESFULL 25th SERVAIS CONCERT

The Servais concerts celebrated their silver jubilee. On 22 November 2019 the 25th edition took place. The first one was organized in November 2006 by the Servais Society and the Cultural centre 't Vondel: a classical concert with musicians from (inter)national level, who perform at least one composition by François Servais, the cellist from Halle. The formule has been successful over the last thirteen years.



For the first time a symphonic orchestra was engaged: the Symphonic Orchestra of the Catholic University of Louvain, with 65 young musicians directed by Edmond Saveniers. The concert opened with 'a tribute to Claude Debussy' by the 90 years old Flemish composer Frits Celis, followed by Servais' cello concerto in b minor. That piece was brilliantly performed by the orchestra and Didier Poskin as a soloist. Poskin surprised the audience with an extra composition by Servais: La Romanesca, played on a cello with gut strings, like in Servais' time.

The second part of the concert was dedicated to the second Symphony by Aleksandr Borodin and after a resounding applause, the orchestra ended with Ouverture to Candide by Leonard Bernstein.

### CULTURE DEVIL FOR SERVAIS SOCIETY

On 26th October 2019 the Servais Society received the Culture Devil, a trophy for cultural merit rewarded by the Halle Culture Council every two years on behalf of the more than houndred socio-cultural organisations of the city. It is a bronze sculpture by artist Luc Van Ruysevelt. The Servais Society has been working for sixteen years to promote Servais' life and work. Already in 2007 Peter François, president of the Servais Society, received the same prize thanks to his contribution to the Festival Servais 2007.
