The Festival Servais 2007

On 26 November 2006, the Festival Servais will start. It celebrates the bicentenary of Servais' birth for a whole year.



Official presentation of the Festival



On November 8, the *Festival Servais 2007* was presented officially to the public and the press in the Historical City Hall. In his introducing speech, mayor Dirk Pieters (*photo*) emphasized the importance of the festival for the (inter)national influence of Halle as a culture city with a rich history.

November 26, 2006: start of the Festival Servais 2007

There will be a celebration at 10 AM in the basilica of Halle. During this celebration the Finnish cellist *Seeli Toivio* will play some intermezzos. Afterwards, there will be a ceremonial at the grave of Servais at 11.15 AM at the cemetery of Halle. Speeches will be delivered by *Peter François*, president of the Servais Society, *Dirk Pieters*, mayor of Halle and Rev. *Raymond Decoster*, dean of Halle.

At 8 PM the big opening concert begins. About twenty promising cellists appear on stage. They are all students of Viviane Spanoghe and Jeroen Reuling at the Royal Conservatory of Brussels, where Servais himself had been a student and afterwards a professor for eighteen years. On the program: light romantic music by Adrien François Servais, Anton Rubinstein, David Popper and others.
