11th Servais Concert on June 3, 2011

Romain Dhainaut was a student at the Conservatories in Brussels and The Hague and is now completing his studies at the London Academy of Music. In 2009 he won the third prize at the International Servais Cello Concours, held in 2009. Together with pianist Pierre Brunello he will pay tribute to Servais, exactly three days before his 204th anniversary.

The Halle audience will be treated to two works that have never been performed in our town since Servais' life. On the occasion of the 'Liszt Year 2011' the programme also features work by Franz Liszt, the famous virtuoso, with whom he gave numerous performances. No doubt, this is going to be an excellent musical evening with enjoyable romantic music by Servais and his contemporaries.

Looking back

Cello Master Classes

Between April 11 and 15, 2011 the Servais Society organized cello master classes at the Halle Servais Academy. Ms Viviane Spanoghe of the Royal Brussels Conservatory was the cello tutor with Paul Hermsen as the piano accompanist. The classes were attended by three Belgian, two Spanish participants, and one from France, one from America and one from the Czeck Republic. At the moment all of them are studying in Belgium or the Netherlands.



From early morning till late in the evening the cello sound could be heard during the individual classes and the joint and separate rehearsals. The participants were very enthusiastic about the historic venue as well as the pleasant town centre, which they discovered during the breaks and during the Servais walk. Zeger Desmet and Peter François guided them through Servais' Halle, with special attention for the Basilica Church and the central Market Square.

Also a visit to the Servais rooms of the Museum was a must. And so these young cello players got to know their famous predecessor Servais, who was extremely popular all over Europe in the 19th century.

On Friday evening the eight cellists gave a closing concert. Their performance opened jointly with three rounds by Mozart. Then Manon Vanbellinghen went on to play Servais' "Lac de Côme" and, together with Zuzana Jirglova, Julia Garcia Lavandero executed Luigi Boccherini's Sonata in La major. Subsequently Zuzana and Manon performed Servais' "Caprice" opus 11 nr. 2 and it was Sara Lopez Presa who rounded off the first half with the "Adagio con variazioni" of Ottorini Respighi.

The second part of the programme was opened by Charlotte Barbier with the sonata for cello and piano by Claude Debussy. The American participant, Benjamin Swartz, treated us to a fine performance of Servais' adaptation of Chopin's "Nocturne" opus 9 nr.2. He also played the Fuga from Benjamin Britten's "Second Suite". After this Katrien Dupont played the "Méditation Hébraique" by Ernest Bloch and Virginie Procureur concluded the evening with Robert Schumann's "Cello Concerto" in La minor, which she played entirely from memory. Throughout the concert Paul Hermsen saw to the piano accompaniment, and for the grand finale the eight young cello players performed the "Tango passionato" by Eduard Putz.

And then there were drinks, so both the participants and their family could look back on a week full of music, cello and Servais.





Miscellaneous News

- » During the General Meeting of the Servais Society on April 27, 2011 the Annual Report was presented, with a survey of last year's activities and the progress made to extend the Servais collection. The Society was involved in 26 activities, while 95 researchers, musicians and other persons interested were helped by supplying them with scores and other pieces of information. This report can be sent via e-mail to anybody who would care to get it.
- » The "Zuidwestbrabants Museum" will open its doors for a new season. You can look at the fixed set of items about the Servais family. The yearly temporary exhibition offers a selection of the objects and documents the museum was able to acquire over the past few months : a.o. the 19th century restoration plans for the Basilica, believed to be lost, a statue of Our Lady of Halle, paintings by Jozef Colruyt and Louis Thevenet, local porcelain.... And in addition some of Servais' unique letters, photos and scores are on display.

The Museum can be visited between 14 and 17 p.m. on Sundays from April till October; in the months of July and August it is also open on Saturday between 14 and 17 p.m. and on Sunday from 10 p.m. till noon. Groups can visit the Museum at any time if arrangements have been made.
