Thirteenth Servais Concert on June 9 2012

The swiss cello player Wen-Sinn Yang had been first cellist of the symphonic orchestra of the "Bayerische Rundfunk" for sixteen years before he was appointed professor at the Munich "Hochschule für Musik" in 2005. His discography comprises more than twenty titles, among which also work by the Halle cellist Servais and his contemporaries Davidov and Piatti. He is coming to Servais' native town together with the Swiss pianist Adrian Oetiker, a musician and music lecturer invited all over the world. The programme features romantic chamber music by Servais and his contemporaries. For sure, a unique opportunity to attend a performance by Wen-Sinn Yang in our country.

Looking back

Twelfth Servais Concert commemorating Servais' death 145 years ago

On November 25 2011 Alexander Hülshoff and Friedemann Eichhorn were our guests in Halle for the 12th Servais Concert. Besides work by Händel, Mozart, Kodaly and Bartok they also played two duos by Servais. In so doing, they paid tribute to Servais, who died on November 26, 145 years ago. To give this celebration an extra festive dimension a 'special guest' was present: an 1881 copy of the famous 'Servais cello', the Stradivarius cello from 1701, which Servais had played on for 25 years. The original instrument is on display at the Smithsonian Institute in Washington and is one of the best and most precious cellos in the world. Alexander Hülshoff himself uses a cello from 1699, which had been in the possession of the Czech David Popper, a colleague and acquaintance of Servais'. For the encore the soloist exchanged his own instrument for the Servais copy, so the audience was able to get acquainted with the wonderful sounds of that particular instrument. This cello has recently been acquired by the Servais Society.



Cello masterclasses 'Servais' 2012

Between April 10 and 14 the Servais Society managed to organize, once more, masterclasses in the Halle Servais academy for young cello musicians, students and graduated players. This time the master was Gavriel Lipkind, who is touring the world virtually all the time for performances and CD recordings. Yet he was able and... willing to insert a week's stay in Halle into his very busy professional schedule.



Our Society wanted to focus on Servais' 205th birthday by means of this event. For some thirty years Servais travelled through Europe as one of the most honoured cello virtuosi of that age. Even today his compositions are being performed all over the world and recorded on CD. He contributed in a special way to the development of the cello technique. As a lecturer at the Brussels Royal Conservatory of Music he passed on his know-how to new generations of cellists who came from all over Europe to Brussels to be his students. Consequently, the best way to celebrate Servais' birthday was organizing these cello masterclasses in his native town, given by a reputable master at a European level and attended by participants from Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany, Israel and Russia.


On April 10 Gavriel Lipkind gave a much appreciated recital together with pianist Michael Kravtchin to open the masterclasses in a festive way. They performed work by Schumann, Bach and Beethoven. And on Saturday evening April 14 the participants presented a final concert. Both the varied programme and the excellent performance met with enthusiastic approval from the audience.



Short news survey

This year we are celebrating the bicentenary anniversary of the Flemish novelist Hendrik Conscience. The town of Halle and neighbouring Beersel organize a range of festivities, in which our Society will join. Indeed, there is a link between the author and Servais, which as a matter of course will be highlighted in an exhibition set up in the local 'Zuidwestbrabants Museum' and also in a new book by Peter François, 'Hendrik Conscience in Halle'.

- » On January 15 Bengt Widlund, cellist in the 'Nederlands Philharmonisch Orkest' came to Halle to visit the Servais Collection. This was an opportunity for him to play on the copy of Servais' Stradivarius, kept in Halle.
- » From June 12 till September 9 2012 an exhibition will be staged in the Paris Musée d'Orsay about Servais' granddaughter Misia, entitled 'Misia, Reine de Paris'. Portraits of Misia and her contemporaries are linked to interpretations of present-day artists.

» An international conference will be organized in La Spezia (Italy) dealing with 'The Franco-Belgian Violin School from G.B. Viotti to E. Ysaÿe' (July 9 till July 11). Peter François will be giving a talk on Servais' concert trips and those of Servais' friends, violinists De Bériot, Vieuxtemps, Ghys and Léonard.
