POLISH SUCCESS FOR SERVAIS

On 21 March 2019 Servais was being celebrated in Krakow. The second evening of the Cello Spring festival was fully dedicated tot he Halle cellist. Peter François was invited to give a lecture on Servais' life and work. Maria Czaplinska played *Souvenir de Spa*, Pawel Czarakcziew continued with the *Fantaisie et Variations brillantes sur le Désir*, Gabriela Karpiesiuk played the *Fantaisie sur deux airs russes* and Aleksandra Lignar ended with the *Fantaisie sur la Fille du Régiment*. The audience in the Aula Florianka was very enthousiastic about the performance.

Zdzisław Łapiński, head of the cello departement at the Krakow Conservatory, who learned to know Servais'music during his studies, considered Servais' compositions to be very interesting to teach special playing techniques. For that reason he made it compulsory for his students to study a composition by Servais in their second master year. As a result more than fifty young Polish musicians have got acqainted with Servais.

SERVAIS IN BERLIN

On 16 May 2019 the Kammerorchester Berlin performed Servais' *Grande Fantaisie sur le Barbier de Séville*, with Wen-Sinn Yang as a soloist. This cellist has played Servais for more than ten years, and made a cd fully dedicated to Servais. According to him Servais is one of the most important cellists of the nineteenth century, together with Piatti, Davidov and Popper. The numerous public could appreciate Servais' Fantaisie very well.

Peter François attended this concert and combined his stay in Berlin with research in the Staatsbibliothek, the national library of Germany, which keeps no less than 97 old editions of



Servais' music. Recently the library obtained a part of the archives of the music editor B. Schott's Söhne, that contains many traces of Servais.
