In order to collect money the owners of the Servais Villa will again sell Champagne, this time with a special cap representing the Meyerbeer medallion. The Servais Society will also put the book 'The Belgian School of Cello playing' and the Servais cd by Wen-Sinn Yang on their disposal. The full profit will benefit the action.

Half of the profit will be spent to a smal part of the restoration of the lions and the ornamental vase, the other half will go to the artistic project 'Life in the Servais Villa'.


