
#### COMING SOON: 150 YEARS OF MISIA 1872-2022



Misia Godebska was the grand-daughter of the Belgian cellist François Servais. She was a key figure in the French music world at the beginning of the 20th century.

### UPCOMING: EXPO 'FRANCOIS SERVAIS, THE PAGANINI OF THE CELLO' (9-21 MAI)



François Servais (1807-1866) was a pioneering cellist, a European star and one of the founding fathers of the Belgian School of Cello Playing. He made music with Mendelssohn, Rossini and Vieuxtemps and was rated highly by Schumann, Meyerbeer and Berlioz. One and a half century after his death his virtuoso cello compositions still resound all over the world.

Come and discover his life and work at the exposition in the entrance hall of Flagey during the Queen Elisabeth International Cello Competition.

The exposition can be visited for free from 9 to 21 May, every day (except on Sunday) from 2 till 10 PM.

### LOOKING BACK: 26th SERVAIS CONCERT 28 NOVEMBER 2021



The festive 26th edition of Servais concerts focused on the Spanish School of cello playing. Cellist Javier Escalona and pianist Laura Granero took us on a journey to Andalusia. They showed Servais' influence on Spain by performing works by Servais and Spanish composers such as Pascual Ramayón Barret, Gerónimo Jiménez and Jesús de Monasterio, all worth discovering. Javier played their music in a perfect way and full



of sensitivity, without using a score.



As a surprise also fourteen students of the cello class of the Halle Academy performed three pieces for cello ensemble directed by their teacher Ann Van Hecke. The concert also commemorated the 155th anniversary of Servais' death.

There was also a surprise for Roel Dieltiens, the Belgian top cellist, and also Javier Escalona's teacher. He received a diploma as an honorary member of the Servais Society thanks to his enormous merits as an important representative of the Belgian School of Cello playing, his efforts to demand attention for Servais' music and his support to the activities of the Servais Society.


#### INAUGURATION OF THE ROSSINI BUST ON 9-20 DECEMBER 2021





The marble bust of Rossini, which the Servais Society succeeded to acquire, was festively unveiled on 19 and 20 December 2021 with a special performance by cellist Didier Poskin and pianist Pierre Brunello. They played a work that Rossini especially had composed in favour of Servais and a 'Fantaisie' by Servais of Rossini's best known opera 'the Barber of Sevilla'.

For this first concert in the restored music room of Villa Servais the Servais Society collaborated with Villa Servais and Rotary Halle. On Monday the Deutsche Rossini Gesellschaft was represented by members from Germany and Switzerland. They had largely supported the purchase of the bust, that now permanently shines in the entrance hall of the Villa and can be admired by everyone who attends an activity or visits the tea room.
