NEW EDITIONS IN THE SERVAIS URTEXT SERIES

In 2021 the Servais Society together with Yuriy Leonovich Editions started a series of editions of Servais' compositions, based on the earliest printed editions and manuscripts. Each edition includes a well-researched introduction, providing a better understanding of the work and its genesis. No fewer than 16 new editions have appeared in recent months:

- Caprice sur Le Comte Ory, opus 3 (cello & piano; 2 cellos)
- Souvenir de la Suisse, opus 10 (cello & piano)
- Morceau de Concert, opus 14 (cello & piano)
- O Cara Memoria, opus 17 (cello & piano)
- Concerto Militaire, opus 18 (cello & piano)
- Grand Duo sur Les Huguenots (Servais & Vieuxtemps) (cello & violin)
- Quatre Morceaux de Salon (cello & piano)
- Deux Mazurkas de Chopin (cello & piano)
- Souvenir d'Anvers (cello & piano) edition from manuscript!
- Fantaisie-Caprice pour deux violoncelles (2 cellos) edition from manuscript!
- Fantasia sur La Folle (cello & piano; cello & quintet) edition from manuscript!
- Fantaisie La Romantique (cello & piano; cello & quintet) edition from manuscript!
- Fantaisie sur La Muette de Portici (cello & piano) edition from manuscript!

The last four compositions have never been published before, making them finally performable some 190 years after their creation. They are definitely worth discovering.

LOOKING BACK: SERVAIS CONCERT WITH DUO FORTECELLO

The Duo Fortecello shone on June 3, 2023, at the 29th Servais Concert in the Council Chamber of the New Town Hall in Halle. The Polish cellist Anna Mikulska and the French-Spanish pianist Philippe Argenty have been traveling around Europe for ten years and regularly play the Fantaisie sur deux airs russes by the Halle cellist François Servais. So that work could not be missing from the program. The cellist had to perform breakneck tricks to get all Servais' notes out of her instrument. The role of her duo partner was less challenging. That was different in Servais' duo on Verdi's opera La Traviata: in that piece the pianist also had a starring role. The Nocturne opus 9 No. 2 by Frederic Chopin, in an arrangement for cello and piano by Servais, remains a gem. Servais garnered success with it for years, even decades after his death, and now the people of Halle know why once again. Also played was the Polonaise brillante by Chopin, an unjustly forgotten youthful work by the Polish composer. Another discovery for many was the Sonata in la minor by Spanish cellist Gaspar Cassadó. Rarely heard, but cleverly composed and a delight to the ear. The same goes for the Variations sur un thème slovaque by Slovak Bohuslav Martinů and the Tryptique de l'Ange by Argentine tango composer Astor Piazzolla. The musicians gave brightly flavored explanations for each piece.

They had long looked forward to this performance in Servais' hometown.
